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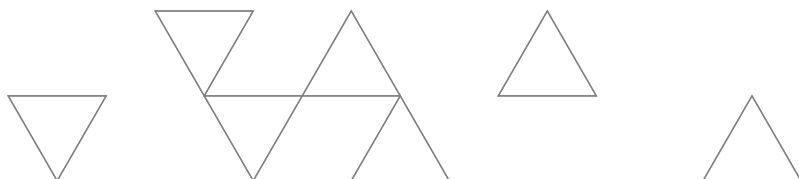
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Why We Exist

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Why should you become a member?

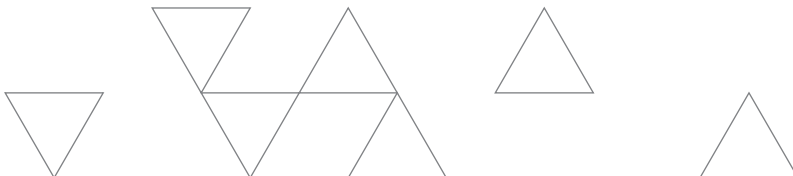
Individuals from member companies are invited to:

- Ensure effective workforce involvement and the best use of Safety Reps and Steering Groups.



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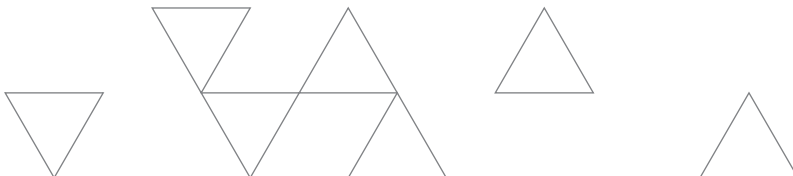
Focal Points

The MD or CEO of a member company has to formally appoint a 'Focal Point' – an individual who will act as a vital link between Step Change in Safety and their company.

A Focal Point must have direct and regular access to their company's management team and HSE manager, and should receive top-level support to help make a positive contribution to the development of their company's safety culture.

A Focal Point is expected to:

- Update their company's MD or CEO and HSE Manager on Step Change matters;
- Internally promote Step Change's initiatives and activities;
- Attend Focal Point meetings and, if necessary, attend meetings on behalf of their company's MD or CEO;
- Encourage and support participation in Step Change's network meetings and events;
- Mentor newly-appointed Focal Points if and when necessary.



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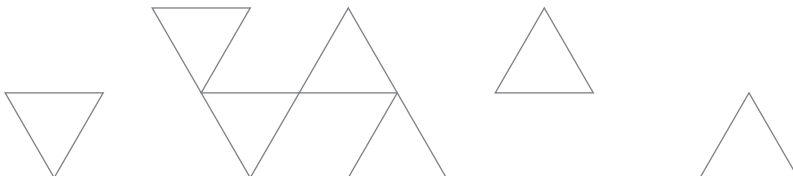
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Money, Money, Money

All of Step Change in Safety's members pay an annual membership fee based on the size of their company.
